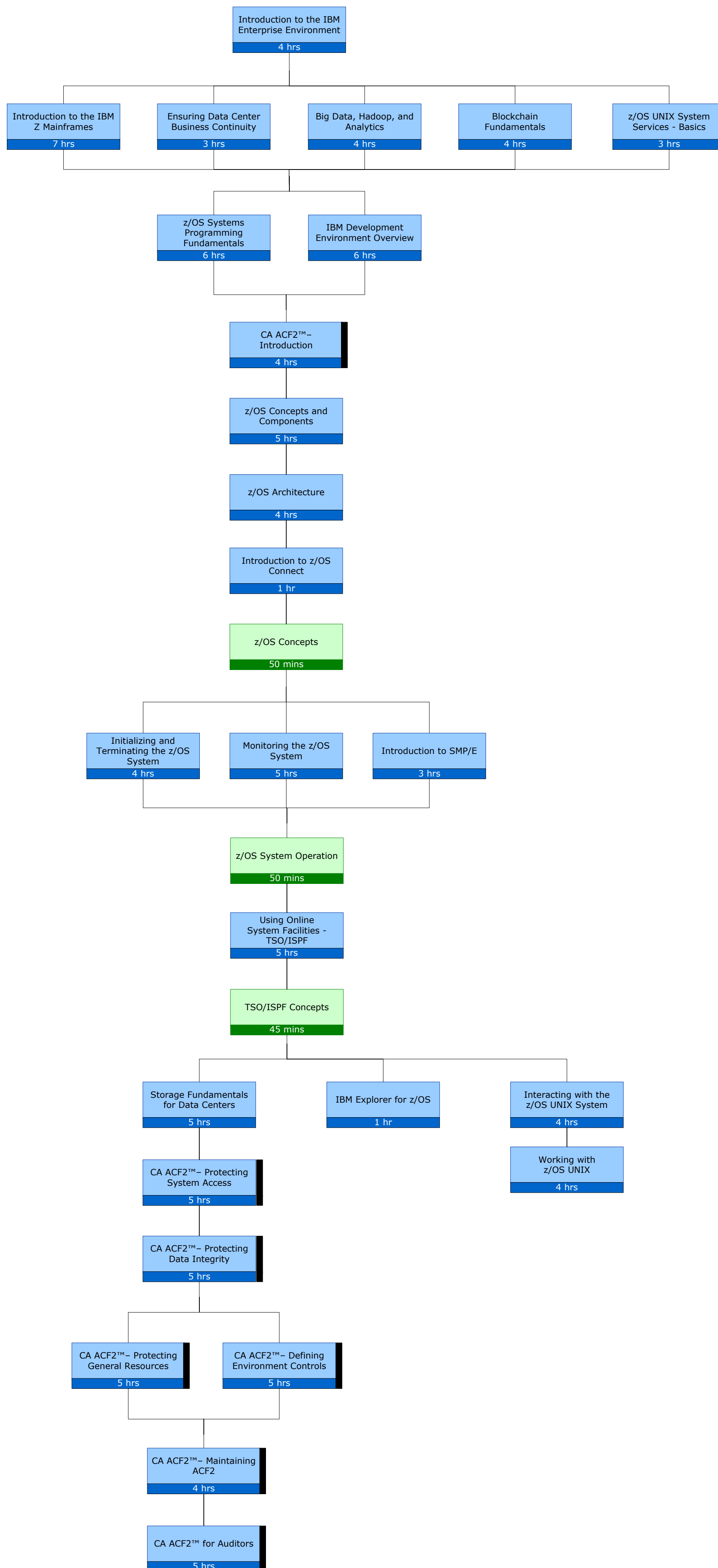


The z/OS system auditor needs to have current in-depth knowledge of z/OS and related systems software including that used for security purposes. Some of the tasks that the auditor will be responsible for reporting on are:

- Potential security exposures
- Network vulnerabilities
- Appropriate security configurations (passwords, privileged accounts and remote access)
- Meeting of compliance obligations
- Backup, recovery and contingency planning
